REA's Courses for Employers and Employees Subject to the Canada Labour Code, Part II

In December 2000, Bill C-12 came into effect and amended the CLC-II to include the requirement for Policy Safety and Health Committees where an employer has more than 300 employees. Subsequent to the addition of the new committees, the roles and responsibilities of existing Workplace Health and Safety Committees were amended. Additionally, Bill C-12 extended the duties of the employer in relation to third parties and with respect to health and safety training requirement for all those functioning in a supervisory/managerial capacity.

It is with these changes in mind that REA is offering the following courses (in both official languages):

- **Workplace & Policy Health and Safety Committees**
- **OHS for Managers & Supervisors**

REA has been working for many years with federal ministries such as Public Works and Government Services Canada (PWGSC), Transport Canada, and Environment Canada in the development and delivery of health and safety courses. We anticipate our new federal courses to be a great success because of the experience and knowledge that we have gained while working closely with these clients.
