October '99 to be Record Month for OHS Penalties

Between October 1st and 15th Ontario courts levied a total of \$805,000 in penalties for OHS Act contraventions. More than half this sum was in the form of two fines against Dominion Castings Limited of Hamilton, and Domtar Fine Papers accounted for a further \$175,000. Fines in the range of \$40,000 to \$75,000 were levied against Burlington Technologies Inc., Santa Maria Foods Corp., FKP Tool Manufacturing Inc., and Amcan Castings Limited. \$275,000 in fines were levied in all of September. Based on year-to-date figures, 1999 totals appear likely to be double the amounts for 1998. (Source: Ontario Ministry of Labour web site)
